

**Record of Decisions**  
PSAC North Regional Council Meeting  
October 14, 2007  
Explorer Hotel – Yellowknife

**1. Northern Strike Pay**

*“Be It Resolved That the PSAC adopt a system of strike pay that recognizes the disparities experienced by Northern workers by increasing strike pay for those members resident in Zone B, as defined by Revenue Canada, to the level of \$75 per day.*

*Be It Further Resolved that such a system increase the amount of strike pay for members residing in Zone A, as defined by Revenue Canada, to the level of \$100 per day.”*

**2. Local Development**

*“Be it resolved that the Regional Coordinator or his designate(s), the REVP, 1 component rep from each territory and 1 territorial director from each territory meet by December 31, 2007 to discuss the issue of local development, how funds are expended and go over the rules that are put in place for this.*

*Be it further resolved that a report of this meeting be given at the first Regional Council meeting in 2008.”*

**3. Refugees from Militarism**

*“Be it resolved that PSAC North Regional Council calls upon the Government of Canada to demonstrate its commitment to international law and the treaties for which it is signatory, by making provisions for U.S. war resisters to have sanctuary in Canada.*

*Be it further resolved that PSAC North Regional Council contribute \$500 to the War Resisters’ Support Campaign.*

*Be it further resolved that PSAC North Regional Council directs its REVP to vigorously lobby the NBOD and the AEC to adopt the above position statement.*

*Be it further resolved that PSAC North Regional Council submits a similar resolution in the next national convention.”*

**4. Bottled Water**

*“Be it resolved that PSAC North should eliminate the use of bottled water at all PSAC North sponsored events.*

***Be it further resolved that staff/organizers of PSAC North events be provided with alternate means of supplying clean tap water when this service is not provided.***

***Be it further resolved that this resolution be forwarded to PSAC National Convention for adoption as a national policy.”***

## **5. Bottled Water #2**

***“Be it resolved that PSAC participate in and support in kind/or financially up to the value of \$100,000 National Campaigns promoting access to clean, public water. Partners could be the AFN, CUPE or Council of Canadians.***

***Be it further resolved that PSAC develop an education model that promotes the importance of maintaining/improving clean public water.***

***Be it further resolved that this resolution be forwarded to the PSAC National Assembly.”***

## **6. TILMA**

***“Be it resolved that PSAC North approach the Yukon Federation of Labour, Northern Territories Federation of Labour, Components and Territorial Directors to mount territory-wide campaigns against TILMA in the NWT, the Yukon and Nunavut.***

***Be it further resolved that PSAC North submit a proposal to PSAC for funding for this campaign from the emerging issues fund for the amount of \$25,000.***

***Be it further resolved that PSAC develop and education unit on TILMA.”***
