CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

REGIONAL EXECUTIVE VICE-PRESIDENT AND ALTERNATE REGIONAL EXECUTIVE VICE- PRESIDENT

PSAC NORTH REGION

This is the official Call for Nominations for the positions of Regional Executive Vice-President and Alternate Regional Executive Vice-President for the PSAC North Region.

Elections for these positions will be held at the PSAC North Regional Triennial Convention 2026, taking place Friday, May 29 to Sunday, May 31, at the Kwanlin Dün Cultural Centre in Whitehorse, Yukon.

A Nominations Form is attached to this document.



Delegates to the **PSAC North Regional Triennial Convention 2026**, taking place from **Friday, May 29 to Sunday, May 31** at the **Kwanlin Dün Cultural Centre** in **Whitehorse, Yukon**, will be electing the Regional Executive Vice-President (REVP) and the Alternate Regional Executive Vice-President (Alternate REVP) for the PSAC North Region. Any PSAC member in good standing who lives and/or works in the North Region (Yukon, Northwest Territories, or Nunavut) is eligible to run for these positions. The nominator and seconder must be accredited delegates to the PSAC North Regional Triennial Convention.

As Associate Director, I have been assigned the responsibility for sending out the Call for Nominations, receiving the nominations in advance of the Regional Triennial Convention, and working with the Nominations Committee at the Convention itself.

The following information outlines how the election procedures will work, and what a member should do if they want to run for office.

NOMINATIONS

A Nominations Committee will be appointed by the North Regional Council and ratified on the Convention floor. The Chairperson of the Nominations Committee will be appointed by the North Regional Council and will conduct the elections for the positions of REVP and Alternate REVP. The Chairperson has the power to appoint scrutineers and assistants deemed necessary to conduct the elections in an orderly manner.

In my capacity as Associate Director, I have been tasked with facilitating the nomination process in advance of the Convention. I am also responsible for ensuring that the nominations are filed with the Nominations Committee in writing and signed by the nominator and seconder, each of whom must be an accredited delegate to the North Regional Triennial Convention.

ELIGIBILITY

Candidates nominated for the position of REVP and Alternate REVP do not have to be a delegate to the Convention, but must be a member in good standing and live or



work in the North Region. The nominator and seconder must be delegates at the North Regional Triennial Convention.

FORM SUBMISSION

A Nomination Form for the position of REVP and Alternate REVP is attached.

Nominees who will not be present at the North Regional Triennial Convention must submit a Nomination Form to the North Region Associate Director, François Picard, prior to the start of the Convention.

Nominees who will be present at the North Regional Triennial Convention can submit a Nomination Form to the North Region Associate Director, François Picard, prior to the start of the Convention, or to the Nomination Committee during convention, or be nominated from the floor of the Regional Convention.

ELECTION EXPENSES

As outlined by **Regulation 21, Regulation Governing PSAC Election Expenditures** of the PSAC Constitution and Regulations, the spending limit for the candidates seeking the office of the Regional Executive Vice-President is \$4,500 and the spending limit for candidates seeking the office of the Alternate Regional Executive Vice-President is \$3,500. The cost of suite/rooms shall not be included in the spending limit.

Donated literature, posters, handouts, buttons and other paraphernalia, food and refreshments shall be included in the spending limit.

Candidates are required to submit a report of campaigns expenses to the National Board of Directors within four (4) months of the date of election. The expense report shall be accompanied by supported invoices for all expenses.

RELOCATION EXPENSES

Section 18, Sub-Section (3) (b) of the PSAC Constitution stipulates that “REVP positions shall be prepared to live in a location where there is a PSAC Regional Office as determined by the AEC.”

Therefore, as outlined by **Regulation 16, Regulation Governing the Relocation of Full-Time Elected Officers of the PSAC Centre** of the PSAC Constitution and Regulations, a member who is elected as a full-time officer of the PSAC Centre (i.e. the Regional Executive Vice-President) shall be paid relocation expenses when at the time of election the member is residing outside of the regional location as determined by the Alliance Executive Committee and the elected individual must move in order to comply with the requirements of the PSAC Constitution.
